The representatives of the earliest families state that the wild ducks and wild geese were very abundant. The word has been spelled Missisco and Missiskoui. Dear Sir: Your letter of April 13, making inquiries regarding the Indian term Missisquoi, is at hand. Without knowing the history of the term, it is impossible to give a full and satisfactory definition; but it is an Algonquin word, and, as it stands, would seem to be made up of the two elements, missi, great, large, much, and assisku, mud, soft clay. The first part of the word corresponds to the first syllables in our two words, Mississippi and Missouri. The second part corresponds more closely to the second part of the word Missouri, which signifies turbid; the second part of the word Missisquoi signifying, however, simply soft clay or mud.
