

Explores why Argentina fell from the rapid growth spiral it experienced in the beginning of the 20th century. The authors use econometric analysis to identify exactly when things began to go wrong and correlate historical economic policies with these periods. Over-reaction to the effect of the Great Depression on Argentina's economy and the consequent turning inwards, reinforced in the 1940s, associated with a heavy emphasis on the state sector, which effectively stifled private initiative and investment, are largely responsible. It was only when such policies were definitively abandoned that the economy began to stabilize and grow. The lessons of this unique analysis are equally relevant for other countries seeking to understand the errors of the past in order to build a better future.
